1. **Dr. Gustav Winkler Scholarship for Israeli Students of MINT-Subjects**

Four intensive language training scholarships will be awarded in 2016: two for Israeli university students and two for Israeli College (Michlala) students majoring in mathematics, computer sciences, natural sciences or preferably technology. The language course will be offered by a German language institute within the Federal Republic of Germany.

2. **Scholarships for language courses in Germany - Summer 2017**

We are now accepting applications for German language courses. There are two courses available:

- **Intensive Language Course (Level A2-B1)**

Aimed at Bachelor or Master students, who have completed levels A1-B1. Bachelor students are eligible to apply for the scholarship from their second year of studies. Faculty members and PhD students are also eligible to apply.

- **University Summer Course (Level B1+)**

Aimed at Bachelor or Master students, who have German language proficiency equivalent to level B1 and higher.

3. Lecture: Heinrich Heine, the New York Intellectuals, and Critical Theory

We are happy to invite you to a lecture by Prof. Dr. Willi Goetschel (University of Toronto).

The lecture will take place on **Tuesday, November 8th, at 16:30 in the Rabin Building, room 2001, The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, Mount Scopus Campus.**

The lecture is entitled: "Heinrich Heine, the New York Intellectuals, and Critical Theory". It will explore Heinrich Heine's absent presence in the tradition of Critical Theory. While the trajectory of Heine suggestively resonates with the project of Critical Theory, both literary criticism and many of the exponents of Critical Theory have remained resistant to exploring their affinities. Examination of Heine's role in the history of Critical Theory and the New York intellectuals points to a shared engagement with Heine that suggests, as Adorno noted, the need to "reappraise" Heine.

The lecture will be held in English and is open to the public.
